





# Bath & Shower Safety Enhancement Options

*In Order of Decreasing Mobility*

<p><b>Level I</b></p> <p><i>Sitting in Tub For Bath</i></p>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>24in. Vertical Bar</b> – Centered at Elbow Height &amp; aligned with lip of tub or shower;</li> <li>2. <b>18 – 24 in. Diagonal Bar</b> – Mounted as low as possible.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Level II</b></p> <p><i>Standing For Shower</i></p>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>12 – 18in. Vertical Bar</b> – Centered at Elbow Height &amp; aligned with lip of tub or shower;</li> <li>2. <b>16 – 24in. Horizontal Bar</b> – Mounted 32 – 34in. from Tub Floor.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Level III</b></p> <p><i>Sitting on Chair for Shower</i></p>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>16 – 18 in. Vertical Bar</b> – Centered at Elbow Height &amp; aligned with lip of tub or shower;</li> <li>2. <b>18 – 24 in. Diagonal Bar</b> – Upper Mount 36in. from Tub Bottom;</li> <li>3. <b>Shower Stool</b> – Adjustable;</li> <li>4. <b>Hand Held Shower</b> – Wall Mount within Reach from Chair.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Level IV</b></p> <p><i>Sitting on Bath Bench for Shower</i></p>		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>12 – 18 in. Vertical Bar</b> – Centered at Elbow Height &amp; aligned with lip of tub or shower;</li> <li>2. <b>18 – 24 in. Diagonal Bar</b> – Upper Mount 36in. from Tub Bottom;</li> <li>3. <b>Bath Bench</b> - Adjustable;</li> <li>4. <b>Hand Held Shower</b> – Wall Mount within Reach from Bench.</li> </ol>
