Medical Equipment Loan & Recycling Programs

Medical equipment loan programs are places where you can borrow a piece of durable medical equipment (DME) or assistive technology (AT) for a short time period. The most commonly available items include wheelchairs, crutches, canes, walkers, commodes, hospital beds and orthopedic braces. The equipment available varies depending on the loan closet. Some closets charge a nominal fee for the service, while others are completely free.

Recycling centers are places that collect used DME & AT equipment and then give it to people who need it. The recipients become the owner of the used equipment.

Some centers listed below are both equipment loan closets and recycling centers. Please call the center to learn their lending or donation eligibility requirements.
